Recommendation:

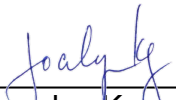
- Receive a report on background information for the East Pleasanton Policy Framework project;
- Confirm that the policy questions described in this staff report should be the focus of continued study; and
- Provide any preliminary input on these policy questions or other project issues.

The City Council and Planning Commission provided feedback in the following categories:

- City Boundaries: Support development of a plan for long-term growth and include expansion of the Urban Growth Boundary.
- Land Uses: Consider industrial and mixed residential uses.
- Open Space and Recreation: Recreational use is of interest for discussion, but is not a focus area.
- Public Service Facilities: Interest in relocation of Pleasanton Garbage Service, but requires further analysis, including cost. Further analysis is needed to determine the feasibility of relocating the Operation Service Center based on the City's available resources.
- Infrastructure and Circulation: Explore financing opportunities provided by new development, especially for the construction of El Charro Road.
