## STAFF COMMENTS/PROJECT UPDATES

### TRAFFIC ENGINEERING

- **WLP Project:**
  - Plans in final design with estimated completion in Summer 2025
    - 65% plans completed with cost estimate of \$36 million, current funding of \$26 million.
  - August 19, 2025, City Council for \$1mil amendment (\$750k ACTC grant) for Phase 2 design
  - Revised final plan design for Phases 1 & 2 in Summer 2026
- **I-580 Overcrossings:**
  - \$250k in HSIP grant funding
  - Staff secured grant funding from ACTC CIP funds
    - August 19, 2025, City Council for approval of agreement with ACTC for \$525,000
    - August 19, 2025, City Council for approval sole source contract (\$700k) for design and Caltrans review
  - Staff to release the RFP for final design and Caltrans approval February 2026
- **Bike/Ped Master Plan Update:**
  - City Council approved a contract with Hexagon on March 18, 2025
  - Kick-off meeting on April 28, 2025, BPTC meeting
  - August 22<sup>nd</sup> – Concert in the Park
  - August 23<sup>rd</sup> – Farmers’ Market
  - September 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> – walk audits
  - November 6, 2025 – PUSD Parent Communication Council meeting

**SUBJECT: STATUS UPDATE ON THE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN  
UPDATE PROJECT**

---

**SUMMARY**

Hexagon will present an update on the current status of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan update and outline the key milestones achieved to date. The presentation will include:

1. Phase 1 Community Outreach Summary
2. Draft Visions and Goals
3. Existing Conditions Analysis

Additionally, Hexagon will outline the next steps in the Master Plan update process. These steps will involve utilizing findings from the trip potential analysis, previous plans, and input from staff, BPTC and the community to develop a draft focus network. Hexagon will then perform a comprehensive needs assessment to identify safety concerns, gaps, and stress factors, as well as establish network prioritization criteria, a treatment toolkit, and a pedestrian Level of Traffic Stress (LTS) methodology. These components will be shared for public feedback during Phase 2 outreach, which will include pop-up events, a community meeting, and an online survey.

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee review and evaluate this information, and provide the consultant and staff with any appropriate feedback or recommendations.

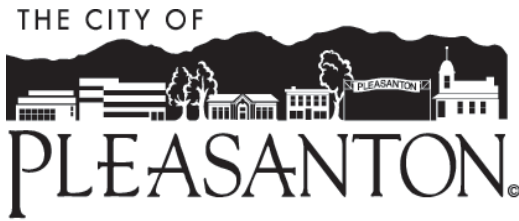

**SUBJECT: SELECTION OF BPTC CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR FOR 2026**

## **SUMMARY**

At the first scheduled BPTC meeting each year, the committee is asked to appoint a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson for the current year. Below is a summary of Section 8 of the current resolution (Resolution No. 2024-003) that defines the structure of the BPTC, which pertains to committee officers:

Committee officers shall be selected and serve as follows:

- a. The Committee by majority vote shall elect for a term of one year a chairperson and vice chairperson from among its members.
- b. The chairperson shall be responsible for the conduct of the meetings.
- c. The vice chairperson shall act for the chairperson in the latter's absence.
- d. No member of the Committee shall serve more than two successive full terms as chairperson.
