City Manager

1. Continued from June 16, 2026 - Introduce an ordinance updating the Pleasanton Municipal Code Title 2 to modify the duties, frequency of meetings, and maintenance of membership for the Civic Arts, Human Services, Library, and Parks and Recreation Commissions, and modify the membership and meeting frequency for the Youth Commission

Community and Economic Development

2. Introduce Revised Ordinance No. 2308 of the City Council of the City of Pleasanton approving: (1) Initiation of proceedings for Annexation (P25-0115), (2) General Plan Amendments (P25-0116), (3) Rezoning (P25-0118), (4) a Planned Unit Development (PUD-154) plan for residential development with related on- and off-site infrastructure, and (5) a Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map (Tract 8423) Associated with the Arroyo Lago Residential Project. The revisions add two new conditions of approval for wastewater treatment facility analysis and funding.

3. Accept a report on City Manager-approved contracts and purchase orders for the quarter ended June 30, 2026
4. Accept the monthly disbursements and investment report for June 2026

Authorize the Interim City Manager to enter into a second amendment to the Livermore-Pleasanton Fire Department (LPFD) Joint Powers Authority Agreement with Stoel Rives LLP for work related to the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board's PFAS investigation of various LPFD facilities in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000

Information Technology

6. Authorize the City Manager to execute a three year agreement with Darktrace Holdings, Limited, for cybersecurity detection and response software and managed detection and response services in an amount not-to-exceed \$935,373
7. Authorize the City Manager to execute a purchase agreement with Spearus, LLC for replacement supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) server and storage infrastructure in an amount not to exceed \$289,532

9. Receive a presentation on debt financing regarding water improvement projects and adopt a resolution declaring the City's intention to reimburse expenditures relating to capital improvement projects from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations
10. Adopt a resolution to deny applications for: (1) a Planned Unit Development (PUD) Rezoning (P26-0360) to rezone the subject parcel from MU-T (Mixed Use-Transitional) District to PUD-MU-T (Planned Unit Development-Mixed Use-Transitional) District; (2) a Certificate of Appropriateness to demolish an existing 6,160-square-foot commercial office building in the Downtown Revitalization District; and (3) a PUD Development Plan (PUD-152) to construct a three-story, four-unit, residential building, with units ranging in size from 430 square feet to 13,626 square feet and associated site improvements located at 231 Old Bernal Avenue

Notice

Under Government Code §54957.5, any writings/documents regarding an open session item on this agenda and items received by the City Clerk's Office by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting provided to a majority of the City Council after distribution of the agenda packet will be available for public inspection on the City's website <https://www.cityofpleasantonca.gov/> and also at the Pleasanton Library located at 400 Old Bernal Ave., Pleasanton, CA 94566.

There is a 90-day limit for the filing of a challenge in the Superior Court to certain City administrative decisions and orders, which require a hearing by law, the receipt of evidence, and the exercise of discretion. The 90-day limit begins on the date the decision is final (Code of Civil Procedure § 1094.6). Further, if you challenge an action taken by the City Council in court, you may be limited, by California law, including but not limited to Government Code §65009, to raising only those issues you or someone else raised in the public hearing, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council prior to or at the public hearing. The City Council may be requested to reconsider a decision if the request is made prior to the next City Council meeting, regardless of whether it is a regular or special meeting.
