Associate Planner Megan Campbell provided a staff update on gas leaf blower bans and sustainability awards.

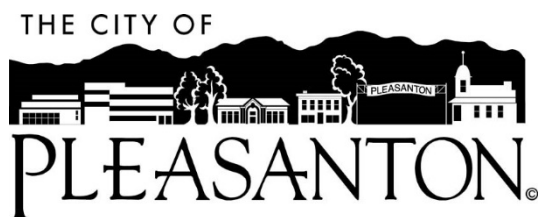
